Reference: Transponders

RECOMMENDATION

To all contestants

It is highly recommended that with the ongoing use of Transponders at the National Events that you fit a permanent mount for the transponder to your race vehicle.

As proven, some vehicles are notorious at not transmitting the required signal through the bodywork.

It is recommended that you fit a mounting plate measuring 50mm wide by 70mm high to your vehicle with an open view to the ground. The other option is to buy a mounting bracket from MXTiming for the cost of \$20 and permanently fit the bracket to your race vehicle.

The key to a good location is no more than 600mm above the ground, a straight and unimpeded view of the ground in a protected area to avoid being wiped off or receiving wheel thrown rocks, mud etc. The US imported cars have mounting brackets on the rear firewall in front but to the side of the gearbox and inside the wheel line which give perfect results. (Refer photo). We also have to find common ground as to where the transponder should be mounted in the length of the race vehicle, so therefore it will be positioned behind the driver's seat but in front of the rear axle.
